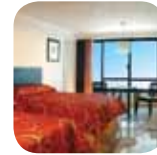

It will be a joint meeting with the **LIII Congress of the Agrupación Mexicana para el Estudio de la Hematología A.C. (AMEH)**. The ISH was founded in 1946, whereas the AMEH was founded in 1959.

The ISH has held previously three meetings in México, in 1946, 1962 and 1994. In fact, the very first meeting of the ISH was held in 1946 in both Dallas and México City; in 1962, the IX World Congress of the ISH was held in México City, whereas in 1994, the XXV ISH World Congress was held in Cancún, México.
